Rules & Regulations:

1. COMPETITION OPEN TO THE WORLD
2. Where there is no competition, premiums will be given only when the entry is deserving. Decision of the Judge is final
3. Superintendents will assign stalls
4. All animals must be recorded regardless of age and appear in the name of the exhibitor on their records of their respective association
5. DO NOT make entries in champion classes
6. Only two entries may be shown in the single classes and only one in the group classes BY ANY ONE EXHIBITOR
7. **CATTLE EXHIBITOR'S HEALTH REGULATIONS**—Livestock exhibitors must be responsible for the removal of dead livestock during the FAIR and thereafter, otherwise exhibitors will not receive premium money until dead livestock is removed in accordance with the Chairman of said Department
8. **Premium Checks** will be mailed to exhibitors
9. **Mulch** bedding is required and will be provided for open class exhibitors only
10. ALL beef cattle must have necktie ropes
11. No tie-outs before 8:00PM and cattle must be in barns by 8:00AM each morning
12. All entries subject to committee approval

LEPTOSPIROSIS VACCINATION RECOMMENDATION:

To protect your cattle and swine herds, the Division of Animal Industry recommends that all cattle and swine that are to be exhibited be vaccinated against Leptospirosis. The vaccination should be in accordance with the recommendations of your Veterinarian and done more than ten (10) days prior to the opening date of the Fair, and within the past year.
