**IMPORTANT – Walk in Entries will be open August 11, 12, 15 & 16 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
If mailed, entries must be postmarked by August 15. None will be accepted after that date.**

NOTE: ALL STOCK MUST REMAIN THROUGHOUT THE FAIR OR THE EXHIBITOR
WILL FORFEIT PREMIUMS.

Dairy cattle must be in place not later than 6:00 a.m. August 31.

Beef cattle may arrive on Friday night after 10:00 p.m. or be in place by Saturday 9:00 a.m.

All Beef Breeding animals may leave on Sunday after 11:00 P.M. or after the Dance, whichever is later.

Where there is no competition, premiums will be given ONLY when the entry is deserving.

Decision of the Judge will be final.

ENTRY FEE IS \$6.00 PER HEAD, BEEF & DAIRY.

Be sure to specify number of stalls needed.

ENTRY FEE MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY.

NO FREE EXHIBITOR TICKETS WILL BE ISSUED. EXHIBITOR TICKETS ARE AVAILABLE FOR \$25.00 EACH which entitles you to six daily gate admissions and parking in infield.

Competition open to the world.

All animals must be recorded regardless of age and appear in the name of the exhibitor on their records of their respective association.

DO NOT make entries in champion classes

Only two entries may be shown in the single classes and only one in the group classes BY ANY ONE EXHIBITOR.

Livestock exhibitors must be responsible for the removal of dead livestock during the Fair and there after, otherwise exhibitors will not receive premium money until dead livestock is removed in accord with the Chairman of said Department.

LEPTOSPIROSIS VACCINATION RECOMMENDATION:

To protect your cattle and swine herds, the Division of Animal Industry recommends that all cattle and swine that are to be exhibited be vaccinated against Leptospirosis. The vaccination should be in accordance with the recommendations of your Veterinarian and done more than ten (10) days prior to the opening date of the Fair, and within the past year.

All animals may leave from 11:00 PM Sunday thru 6:00 AM Monday.

REGISTRATION PAPERS COULD BE CHECKED

Exhibitor must own animals for all group classes. No borrowing permitted.

THE DATE FOR COMPUTING AGES FOR BEEF BREEDS OF CATTLE SHALL BE:

Senior Yearling	Calved between Sept. 1, 2009 and December 31, 2009
Junior Yearling	Calved between January 1, 2010 and April 30, 2010
Summer Yearling	Calved between May 1, 2010 and August 31, 2010
Senior Calf	Calved between September 1, 2010 and December 31, 2010
Intermediate Calf	Calved between January through March, 2011
Junior Calf	Calved March thru June, 2011
Exhibitor's Herd	Shall consist of one Bull, any age, Cow 2 years old or over, yearling heifer and Heifer calf.
Produce of Dam	Shall consist of 2 animals, any age, produce of one cow.
Get of Sire	Shall consist of 3 animals, any age, the get of one sire.
