**IMPORTANT – Walk in Entries will be open August 11, 12, 15, & 16 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.  
If mailed, entries must be postmarked by August 15. None will be accepted after that date.**

All sheep must be in place not later than 6:00 a.m. August 31.

Market Lambs must be weighed August 30, between 7 & 10 pm.

**ALL SHEEP MUST SHOW IN RING TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR PREMIUMS  
A VETERINARIAN HEALTH CERTIFICATE IS REQUIRED**

**Where there is no competition, premiums will be given ONLY when the entry is deserving.  
Decision of the Judge will be final.**

**Competition open to the world.**

**ENTRY FEE IS \$6.00 PER HEAD unless specified otherwise.** Be sure to specify number of pens needed.

**ENTRY FEE MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY. “SUPERINTENDENTS WILL ASSIGN STALLS.”**

**NO FREE EXHIBITOR TICKETS WILL BE ISSUED. EXHIBITOR TICKETS ARE AVAILABLE FOR \$25.00 EACH** which entitles you to six daily gate admissions and parking in infield. **DO NOT** make entries in champion classes.

All animals must be recorded regardless of age and appear in the name of the exhibitor on their records of their respective association. Each exhibitor must be prepared to show registration papers if called for by the Chairman of the Sheep Committee

Yearlings one year old and under two, and lambs under one year.

Breeder’s young flock shall consist of one ram, two yearling ewes and two ewe lambs, bred and owned by exhibitor.

Only two entries may be shown in the single classes and only one in the group classes **BY ANY ONE EXHIBITOR.**

**NOTE: ALL STOCK MUST REMAIN THROUGHOUT THE FAIR OR THE EXHIBITOR  
WILL FORFEIT PREMIUMS.**

**NOTE: Exhibitors will furnish their own bedding.**

All Livestock Trucks Use the Apple Street Gate.

NOTE: Premium Checks will be mailed out to Exhibitors

Livestock exhibitors must be responsible for the removal of dead livestock during the Fair and there after, otherwise exhibitors will not receive premium money until dead livestock is removed in accord with the Chairman of said Department.

All animals may leave from 11:00 p.m., or after the dance, whichever is later, Sunday thru 6:00 AM Monday.

Weight breaks to be at the discretion of the Committee after weigh-ins.

### CONTAGIOUS ECTHYMA (SOREMOUTH) VACCINATION RECOMMENDATION

To protect sheep flocks from contagious ecthyma (sore mouth), the Division of Animal Industry recommends that all sheep be vaccinated for contagious ecthyma (sore mouth) six weeks prior to entering the exhibition circuit. The vaccination should be done by and in accordance with the recommendations of your Veterinarian.

Each entry may include one or more children depending on choice of entry. Exhibit will be judged on the decoration of a Sheep and entrant as to the artistry, attractiveness and originality. Entrants must be relative of Sheep exhibitor or sponsored by Open Class exhibitor or a Member of the Montgomery or Preble County Sheep Improvement Association. Entrant is free to choose their own colors, designs and materials for exhibition in class. May bring own sheep with health papers.

**RULES:**

Entrants can be Exhibitors in Junior Fair or Open Class Sheep Shows. Entrants must be responsible for obtaining their own Sheep to exhibit during the Lead Class. The Sheep must be ewe or market lamb, broken to lead on halter and groomed to show condition. The ewe or wether must be shown in a halter. Any violation of this ruling will result in immediate disqualification of the contestant. Costumes are to be of fabric or yarn that is at least 60% wool. Entrants will be judged on poise and presentation, general appearance, garment construction, and the behavior and grooming of the sheep. There shall be no decorations on the animal or halter. May bring own sheep with health papers.

Premiums for each level:

1st prem. - \$25.00 & Plaque

2nd Prem. - \$20.00 & ribbon

3rd Prem. - \$18.00 & Ribbon
