If mailed, entries must be postmarked by August 15. None will be accepted after that date.**

**ALL SWINE MUST BE ENTERED IN ‘OWNERS’ NAME.
COMPETITION OPEN TO THE WORLD (EXCEPT CARCASS CLASS)
OPEN CLASS SWINE TO USE ONLY SHAVINGS FOR BEDDING**

**Where there is no competition, premiums will be given ONLY when the entry is deserving.
Decision of the Judge will be final.**

ENTRY FEE IS \$6.00 PER HEAD INCLUDING PENS. Be sure to specify number of pens needed. ENTRY FEE MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY. “SUPERINTENDENTS WILL ASSIGN PENS.” NO FREE EXHIBITOR TICKETS WILL BE ISSUED. EXHIBITOR TICKETS ARE AVAILABLE FOR \$25.00 EACH which entitles you to six daily gate admissions and parking in infield. DO NOT make entries in champion classes.

**RULES and REGULATIONS – BREEDING GILT and BARROW SHOW
ALL BARROWS MUST GO TO HARVEST. BREEDING GILTS MAY RETURN HOME.**

NOTE: All stock must remain throughout the fair or the exhibitor will forfeit premiums.

All animals must be in place no later than 10:00 p.m. Tuesday, August 30.
All barrows and gilts must be weighed Tuesday, August 30. Sonaray will be done between 8:00 – 9:00 p.m. only.

ANIMALS TO BE EXHIBITED AND JUDGED – Wednesday, August 31, 10:00 a.m.

Do not make entries in champion classes
Only two entries may be shown in the single classes BY ANY ONE EXHIBITOR.
Animals in Barrow Show and Market Gilt classes may be purebred or crossbred.

Livestock exhibitors must be responsible for the removal of dead livestock during the Fair and thereafter, otherwise exhibitors will not receive premium money until dead livestock is removed in accord with the Chairman of said Department.

NOTE: EXHIBITORS WILL FURNISH THEIR OWN BEDDING.

Must be Barrow. Weight 230 – 280 lbs. No tolerance. Classes will be divided by Committee according to weight. Exhibitor may make 6 entries but show no more than 2 pigs per class.

Must be Gilts. Weight 230-300 lbs. No tolerance. Classes will be divided by Committee according to weight. Exhibitor may make 6 entries but show no more than 2 pigs per class. Premiums are the same as Line 301 above.

ALL CARCASS CLASS EXHIBITORS MUST PAY ENTRY FEE OF \$8.00. Judging will be based on sonoray data. Carcass hogs will be sonorayed at weigh-in at the Fair on Tuesday between 8 & 9 pm. Judging will be based on percent lean of live weight.

Each 4-H/FFA or Open Show exhibitor may enter only (1) one animal in Carcass Class Contest. That animal may also show in Junior or Open Show.

Open to members of Montgomery Co. Pork Producers Assn., 4-H or FFA only. Only one entry per person.
