AUGUST 16, AS FOLLOWS:

By Mail – Anytime after receiving the Fair book, but POSTMARKED no later than August 15.

In Person – At the Entry Department, just inside the Main Gates, during Entry Week, **August 11, 12, 15, 16** between the hours of 9 am – 5 pm.

DO NOT BRING ARTICLES IN AT THIS TIME.

Entry Fee: \$1.00 for each entry.

ONLY ONE ENTRY PER LINE UNLESS OTHERWISE INDICATED

May make 2 entries in “Any Other Variety” lines

PLEASE NOTE ALL TIMES AND DATES LISTED, NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE.

All entries of CANNED GOODS AND BAKED GOODS must be received in the department between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 30. Any item brought in after receiving deadlines, dates and times, will only be shown for display purposes, no premium will be awarded.

Whole loaf of bread must be brought in for entry. One piece will be cut from loaf & kept for display & judging. The remainder may be taken with the exhibitor. Cookies & candy need only bring in the number required for display. All articles, including decorated cakes, must remain on display until 7:30 a.m. Tuesday, September 6 and must be removed between **7:30 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.** Claim checks from entry tag will be required for removal of entries. **Entries not picked up after 30 days of the fair, becomes the property of the Montgomery County Agricultural Society.**

“Superintendents reserve the right to dispose of any spoiled product as necessary during the fair in order to keep the displays attractive.”

All entries in Division I requiring more than 1 piece will be displayed on plates provided by The Montgomery County Agricultural Society.

Entry Tags or ribbons have no value as to the payment of premiums. Premiums are paid **ONLY** from the records of the judges' book and from which there is **NO** appeal.

All entries must be homemade or home produced from fruits and vegetables grown in the immediate vicinity of the exhibitor.

All canned goods must have been prepared by exhibitor within the years 2010-2011.

ALL JARS WILL BE OPENED FOR FINAL INSPECTION AT THE JUDGES DISCRETION.

All canned goods must be in clear glass jars with new 2-piece lids in attractive form, properly labeled (name of product and year preserved) and shall be tested to the satisfaction of the judge.

No preservatives shall be used in the preparation of fruits and vegetables. Any items found to contain synthetic or commercial concentrate will not be eligible for premium.

Displays in variety classes must be made from articles not entered for a single display. Use pint jars in all cases.

RULES:

1. Entries must use the recipe published here.
2. Entry fee of \$1.00 to be paid when article is brought in on Wednesday. NO PRE-ENTRY REQUIRED.
3. Entries are to be brought to the Round House (Provisions Area) between 9:30 and 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday August 31, 2011.
Judging will be performed by the Montgomery County Agricultural Society President with a panel of judges.
Awards will be announced in the Entertainment Tent during the Pie & Cake Auction.
4. Only one prize will be awarded. All of the entries will be auctioned after the announcement of the winner. Winner will receive the entry fees (minimum \$10.00) and a trophy.

PRESIDENT'S RECIPE

MILE HIGH APPLE PIE*Use this for your recipe.*

Pastry for Double Crust 9 Inch Pie

6-7 Large Tart Baking Apples

3\$ - 1 cup sugar

2 Tablespoons All-Purpose Flour

1 Teaspoon Cinnamon

Several Dashes of Nutmeg

1 Dash Salt

2 Tablespoons Butter

Preheat Oven to 350 degrees

Pare apples and slice thin.

Combine sugar, flour, spices and salt; Mix with apples.

Line 9 inch pie pan with pastry. Heap the apple mixture into pastry mounding in the center. Dot with butter and top with second crust.

Sprinkle with sugar if desired.

Bake at 350 for 60 minutes or until done.

Container for Cookie Jar can be a purchased or homemade. Container should be no larger than 12" x 15" (including decorations). Must be functional and in good taste and must be used for storing cookies. Container must be able to be opened so all cookie varieties can be judged.

Jar must have an assortment of four (4) different kinds of cookies and six (6) of each kind for a total of 24 cookies. Each type of cookie must be bundled separately. All cookies must be made and baked by the exhibitor. Recipe must be included for each variety of cookie, typed on a separate 3" x 5" card for each recipe. Card must contain name of cookie and exhibitor's number.

Judging as follows:

Overall Cookie Quality – 50%

Overall attractiveness of the jar and adherence to the Farm Yard theme – 50%
