For the first time, the traveling science spots Center Of Science and Industry (COSI) educational exhibit comes to the fair with ten hands-on science exploration experiments. A special welcome goes to guest COSI Daisy the Cow who teaches children not only where milk comes from but how to milk a cow. Did you know that a cow produces about eight gallons of milk a day? Did you know that not all dairy cows are black and white but these Holsteins, on average, produce the most milk. Kids and families will learn this and much more!

On Friday of the fair, students from local schools are coming in for a special educational day that will include the Daisy Cow experience and COSI experiments plus county 4-H youth sharing their farm life lessons.
