**IMPORTANT – Walk in Entries will be open August 11, 12, 15 & 16 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
If mailed, entries must be postmarked by August 15. None will be accepted after that date.**

Dairy cattle must be in place not later than 6:00 a.m. August 31.

All Breeding animals may leave on Sunday after 11:00 p.m. or after the Dance, whichever is later.

Where there is no competition, premiums will be given ONLY when the entry is deserving. Decision of the Judge will be final.

ENTRY FEE IS \$6.00 PER HEAD.

Be sure to specify number of stalls needed. **ENTRY FEE MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY. “SUPERINTENDENTS WILL ASSIGN STALLS.”** NO FREE EXHIBITOR TICKETS WILL BE ISSUED. EXHIBITOR TICKETS ARE AVAILABLE FOR \$25.00 EACH which entitles you to six daily gate admissions and parking in infield.

Competition open to the world.

All animals must be recorded regardless of age and appear in the name of the exhibitor on their records of their respective association.

DO NOT make entries in champion classes

Only two entries may be shown in the single classes and only one in the group classes BY ANY ONE EXHIBITOR.

Livestock exhibitors must be responsible for the removal of dead livestock during the Fair and there after, otherwise exhibitors will not receive premium money until dead livestock is removed in accord with the Chairman of said Department.

LEPTOSPIROSIS VACCINATION RECOMMENDATION:

To protect your cattle and swine herds, the Division of Animal Industry recommends that all cattle and swine that are to be exhibited be vaccinated against Leptospirosis. The vaccination should be in accordance with the recommendations of your Veterinarian and done more than ten (10) days prior to the opening date of the Fair, and within the past year.

All animals may leave from 11:00 PM Sunday thru 6:00 AM Monday.

REGISTRATION PAPERS COULD BE CHECKED

Exhibitor must own animals for all group classes. No borrowing permitted.

Senior Yearling not in milk	Calved between Sept. 1, 2009 and Dec. 1, 2009
Intermediate Sr. Yearling	Calved between Dec. 1, 2009 and March 1, 2010
Junior Yearling	Calved between March 1, 2010 and June 1, 2010
Summer Yearling	Calved between June 1, 2010 and Sept. 1, 2010
Senior Heifer Calf & Senior Bull Calf	Calved between Sept, 2010 and Dec. 1, 2010
Intermediate Heifer Calf	Calved between Dec. 1, 2010 and March 1, 2011
Junior Heifer Calf	Calved after March 1, 2011 and over 4 months
Dairy Herd	Shall consist of five (5) females: - 2 cows, 2 unfreshened Heifers or calves and one any age, all owned by the Exhibitor.
Produce of Dam	Shall consist of two (2) animals, any age, the produce of one Cow
